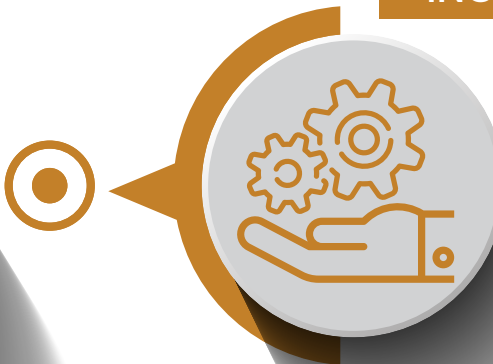
LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS

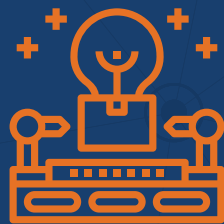
